Basho's haiku were published in numerous anthologies, and he edited Kai Oi, or Seashell Game (1672), and Minashiguri, or Shriveled Chestnuts (1683), anthologies that also included a selection of his own work. In his late 20s Basho moved to Edo (now a sector of Tokyo), where he joined a rapidly growing literary community.

Matsuo Bashō (芭蕉, 1644–1694), born 芭蕉, then Matsuo Chūemon Munefusa (松尾 芭蕉 宗房), was the most famous poet of the Edo period in Japan.During his lifetime, Bashō was recognized for his works in the collaborative haikai no renga form; today, after centuries of commentary, he is recognized as the greatest master of haiku (then called hokku).
