Drug allergy is relatively uncommon, accounting for less than 10% of all ADRs. Drug allergy, occurs in 1% to 2% of all admissions and 3% to 5% of hospitalized patients, respectively but the true incidence of drug allergy in the community, and among children and adults, is unknown.

Nevertheless, only a few IgE assays are commercially available for drug allergy diagnosis, with variable predictive values. In some cases, individual laboratory assays, such as ELISA or FEIA, are used. Table 18 summarizes the value of IgE testing for drug allergy for the most relevant studied drug groups.
